SAFE ENVIRONMENT NOTICE-This past February the diocese changed platforms for their Safe Environment program. Those who were certified at that time were imported into the new system. This includes most of our users here at Rosary Chapel. The online training/background check is still good until the end of your 5 years, but the policies need to be signed again. After December 31st of this year, if you have not signed into CMG Connect to update these signatures you will lose your status of Safe Environment compliance. So it is very important that we get this done. The website is as follows: https://owensboro.cmgconnect.org. When you get to the opening page click on "Sign In Here". If you need please call LaToya at 270-444-6383. Once you are logged in you will be directed to your dashboard. Here you will see "Required Training Curriculums" and (scroll down) "Optional Training Curriculums". In the Optional Training choices you will use the yellow arrow to find "A. Required Policy Acknowledgement -Owensboro". Click on "Start Curriculum", and it will take you to the page where you can read and sign the policies. This shows you what you are looking for (blue). Once you are finished it will say "completed", and you can log off the system. Again, if it is not done by December 31, 2019 you will not be eligible as a Safe Environment-compliant adult.
