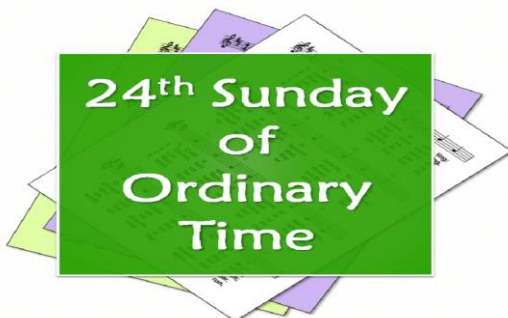
## **Sanctuary Light** for Herman & Anna Reinecke
