#### Reflection

#### Be Thankful to God

The Psalmist says "Lord, it is good to give thanks to You." And that is the absolute truth. It is good to give thanks to the Lord for the countless blessings we receive each day. We give thanks, first and foremost, because it is God's will that we do so. God created and sustains us. God provides for our salvation

through His Son who has given us grace, love and mercy. As God's love for us in Christ is unconditional and everlasting, so too should our thanks be never ceasing regardless of our temporal circumstances. But sadly, the human tendency tilts towards giving thanks to God only in the good times. Now, when it comes to the ugly moments of life, the thanks seem to fade and give way to self-pity, anger, resentment for God and even questioning God – why me? In the real sense, the blessings we receive from God are immeasurable in comparison to the difficulties we may en-



counter. Think about the blessings you might sometimes take for granted – the air you breath, the ability to function each day, the mercy, the forgiveness and compassion, the freedom to live and worship, the electricity, the water, the food, the shelter. In all these and many more, it is certainly good to give thanks to the Lord because God bestows blessings upon us even when we do not deserve. Develop a life of thankfulness to God in everything.
