Reflection

Trusting Christ to Calm Our Storm

The disciples in the gospel today are caught in a storm. Mark writes that the storm was “a violent squall which was breaking over the boat.” The disciples are very terrified thinking they are about to perish. But, with Jesus’ intervention, all was calm.

For us, life can be so full of storms. At times, they can become so strong and strange that our human strength can no longer support. Moments like this bring fear and anxiety. Like the disciples, you might begin to think you are perishing.

In some cases, you might begin to question God’s existence thinking that he may have abandoned you. Even your faith may get tested. These storms come in different forms. They could be problems in your marriage, your children who may not be exactly on the right path. Your storm might be the burden of loneliness, lack of good job, struggling finances or business, or a lingering health problem that has defiled all treatments. These and many more represent the realities we face every day. The bitter truth is that, there is no assurance that our lives would be completely free from storms, but we have an assurance that Christ is with us to calm to storm and to help us succeed.



Year of St. Joseph

On the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, Pope Francis has released an Apostolic Letter about Saint Joseph and has declared a "Year of St. Joseph" which will be observed from December 8, 2020 to December 8, 2021. The letter, *Patris corde* ("a Father's heart") is released on the 150th anniversary of the proclamation of Saint Joseph as patron of the Universal Church.
