

Reflection

Corpus Christi

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ. It is a great Feast for which we focus on the great gift of food for our souls given to us by Christ himself on the night before He suffered. It is something that we are eternally grateful to God for. Each time the Mass is celebrated, the Body of Christ is broken for us and we are in-

vited to the "supper of the Lamb." We are not worthy in any way to partake of this Sacred Eucharistic meal but God invites us to it. Regarding the Eucharist, Saint Augustine once wrote "become what you eat." In other words, if we celebrate the Eucharist with one another and receive that Body and Blood of Christ, unworthy though we are, we are then invited to be the body of Christ in our Church and in our world today. Since we share in the Body and Blood of Christ, we then must work to share our lives with one another. The others may be broken, they may not have it all together, they may be unwelcoming,



yet, we are to be what we have received, Christ, to them. God is ever present to us. God feeds us so that we be strengthened to be present to others.
