



<u>Jubilee Year- Pilgrims of Hope</u> <u>A Time of Grace and Renewal</u>

Understanding the Jubilee Year

A Jubilee Year is traditionally proclaimed by the Universal Church every 25 years. It is a particular year set aside to encourage the faithful to embark on pilgrimages, to repent of their sins and forgive the sins of others, and to renew a focus on the spiritual life. In the Hebrew tradition, as recorded in Leviticus, a Jubilee was celebrated every 50 years with the freeing of slaves and the forgiveness of debts. In 1300, Pope Boniface VIII instituted the first Christian Jubilee, and since then the Church has designated each new Jubilee as a special year of grace and forgiveness, offering the faithful an opportunity to obtain a plenary indulgence.

The locations below, you will find a passport booklet to be stamp at each location, along with prayer cards and scavenger hunts for children to also be able to participate.



How to Receive a Plenary Indulgence During the Jubilee Year

If you make a pilgrimage to one of the 6 designated Jubilee pilgrimage sites, you can receive a plenary indulgence by:

1. Detaching from all sin: This means having a sincere desire to turn away from even small sins and grow in holiness.

- 2. Going to confession, receiving holy Communion, and praying for the pope's intentions:
 - These steps can be done a few days before or after your visit to the pilgrimage site, but it's ideal to receive Communion and say the prayer on the same day.
 - For the prayer, you can say any prayer you choose, but an Our Father and a Hail Mary are suggested.
