



A MYSTERY TO BE LIVED

I read a story online about a man who went up a mountain to meet a guru. The guru asked him, "What can I do for you?" "Well, I know that you are a very wise person. I want you to explain God to me, so that I will do my best to worship him," the man replied. Then the guru told him that, "a God that you can explain is not a God that you should worship."

This weekend we celebrate the Trinity, the doctrine that God is the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. These three persons in one God are equal, undivided, yet distinct. The Father is not the Son, the Son is not the Father, and the Holy Spirit is neither the Son nor the Father. Yet, there is unity of essence in the three distinct divine persons.

The Church has always upheld this unexplainable teaching. Words are insufficient to break down this mystery, and so is human reasoning to understand it. The words of the unnamed sage on the mountain — that a God you can explain is not one you should worship — make much sense here. Therefore, it is safe to say that the Trinity is not a doctrine to be understood. It is a faith to be lived. However, some people ask me, "Why do you have faith in who you do not understand?" That's a good question. Again, I would refer them to the words of the sage and say that "if we understood everything about God, then nothing would be left for faith."

The lesson in the Trinity is the love relationship between the three persons. This love relationship was at work at the time of creation, when the Father, at the point of making humans, said, "let us make man in our own image." The eternal presence of the Son and the Holy Spirit was reflected in the use of the word "us" on that occasion. This love relationship sustains the world. It is our life-giving force. We can emulate the love of the Trinity. In family life, for example, only a relationship of love, unity, and mutual respect — similar to that found in the Holy Trinity — can produce a healthy household. The world is always in need of those families where the husband and wife know one another so well, and together, they know their children, and they all work together in unity and love.

God is one but reveals himself in three persons. Today, he still reveals himself in the different faces of you and me. Whether we bear the face of an Adam or Eve, we are one image of God. Whether with the face of the rich, the poor, or even the beggar on the street, God's image is in us. When these faces come together as one, the image of God shines so brightly in the world.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.
