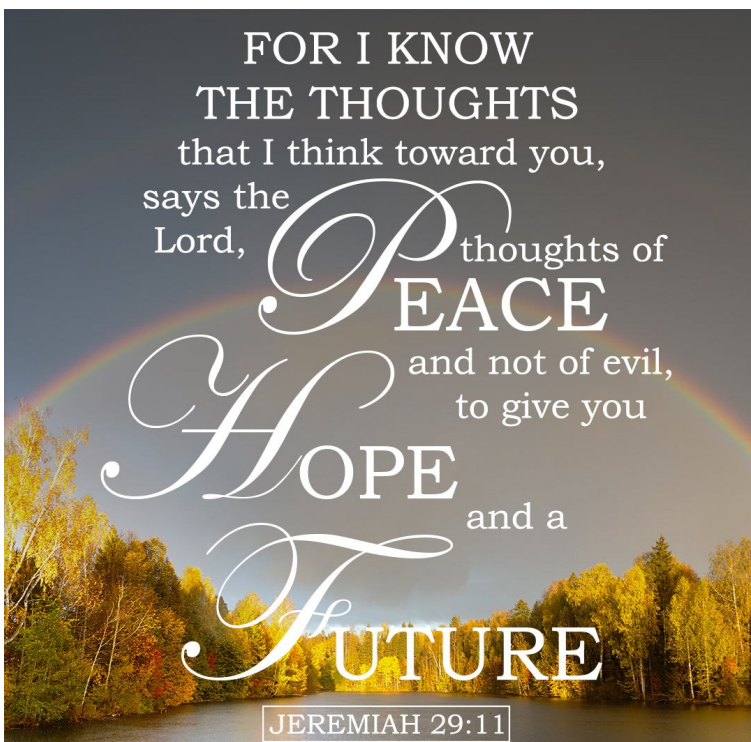
SAVE THE DATE: Sunday, October 18th – We will celebrate the Church's Anniversary with a Parish Potluck.
